Plug in USB Hard Drive Install the program and start it Where it says "Please choose a drive" Make sure you select the correct one (usually the USB type under the BUS title) Click CONTINUE Verify at the top that it's the correct drive and size Click the WIPE tab The warning message is displayed Click WIPE THIS DEVICE Another warning, Click YES You should eventually see blue bars in the "Current task progress" block It will take a while to completely wipe the hard drive.
